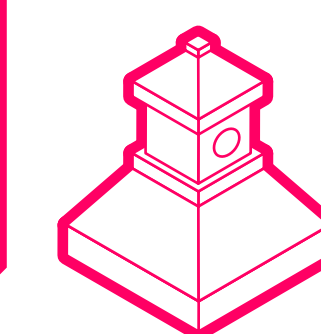
7-9 September 2017 | Riga, Latvia
